Pronunciation: Grew-ner Felt-lean-er

The vintage: '13 greets the nose and palate with a burst of lime, gardenia blossom and white pepper. Bone dry but soft bodied, its generous mid-palate makes the '13 both thirst quenching and incredibly food friendly. We pair this wine equally with seafood, steak and gumbo.
