TASTING NOTE

This wine comes from a small block of vines on the sun-baked slope planted to Clone 30, a varietal that can take the heat. You'll find aromas of rum raisin, juicy black cherry, and hints of thyme and burnt ends. On the palate, the fruit flavors move towards fresh blackberry, joined by tobacco leaf, cinnamon raisin bread, and vanilla bean husk with a meaty finish. Its strong backbone of acidity and puckery tannins suggest that this wine will age beautifully.
