**TASTING NOTE**

Aromas of black cherry, mulberry and sage greet the nose. On the palate, the concentrated black fruit flavors move towards blackberry, along with baking spice, vanilla bean, and fine cigar. This last note alludes to the immense tannin structure of the wine, which dominates the shape of the wine, and which will continue to mature into an increasingly incense-like character. A strong backbone of acidity and full body brace a long pomegranate finish.
