A vibrant mix of varietals from the Kent family's estate vineyards. These vineyards surround an old, flagstone firepit hidden away in the Crane Ridge foothills of Livermore Valley. The vineyards' micro-climate experiences a dramatic diurnal temperature swing: thick blankets of coastal fog in the morning, sunshine and high winds in the afternoon, and chilly temperatures at night.

The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard, combined with Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking, creates a wine that reflects our true-to-terroir winemaking philosophy, only enhanced by nineteen months in French oak cooperage.

Darcie Kent donates proceeds of each bottle sold to the East Bay Regional Parks District.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE BY JULIAN HALASZ

Vibrant aromas of black cherry, plum skin, and boysenberry are joined by flavors of mulling spices and concentrated black plum, with driving acidity and ageworthy tannins.
