STRONG, because Cabernet Franc has the same punch of dark berry flavors, chocolate, and spice as the rest of the family. SILENT, because Cab Franc is earthy, with fine tannins. A good listener, its eminently food friendly.

TASTING NOTE:

Aromas of boysenberry, just ripe plum, and a hint of sandalwood evolve into a dark and earthy palate. There, subtle oak influence and grippy tannins interweave with the 2021's high acidity and pliant mouthfeel. This vintage presents "big bold" flavors while staying light on its feet.
