The Kent family's winemaking history in America dates even further back than the start of their original Alpine Winery (bond #62!). Winemaking styles were a little different back then, prioritizing refreshing sweetness, a mix of varietals and alluring aromatics. This wine is a throwback to our ancestral style.

100% of the grapes were estate grown. The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard is matched by Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking.

## TASTING NOTE

Batch 6 is "just-dry," with aromatics of pineapple candy, mandarin orange, passionfruit, and bright green apple. The tangy palate moves toward key lime, starfruit, and firm white nectarine. This wine has a long finish characteristic of grüner veltliner, which made up a substantial part of the blend.
